The Study Commission is retaining the original definition of immediate family in the Charter. The Section on Political Activity is fine with Commission Members.

The PEL will have the fifth draft of the Charter available next week. This fifth draft should be given to the Commission's solicitor for legal review, if no further changes occur to the draft.

A preamble still needs to be written by the Study Commission. The Commission is starting to make arrangements for the printing of the final report that will be sent to the citizens of Clinton County. Complete copies of the Charter will need to go with each letter of notification and be available at various locations and community leaders in the County.
