



***April 26, 2008 Outdoor Volunteer Conservation Opportunity!***  
**Limited space-Free shuttle service from LHU to the site-Reserve early!**

***Join Clinton Co. CleanScapes in Removing Man-made & Dumped Woody Debris from a PPL's right-of way (proposed Pine Creek Rail Trail connector to Clinton Co.)  
Castanea Township, Clinton County.***

**Where:** Meet at Rt. 220 underpass on East Keller St. (SR 2012), Castanea Twp.  
*Directions: From the corner of Jay & Church Streets in Lock Haven, travel onto Jay Street driving toward Castanea Twp. Travel over the "Castanea Firemen's Memorial Bridge". The roadway name changes to Jarrett Ave. Continue straight. Turn left onto Keller St. Stay on East Keller St. and travel 1.6 miles on Keller St. (SR 2012). Pull-off the roadway near the Rt. 220 underpass & park on the shoulder. CAREFUL-Cleanup event across the roadway and adjacent to Bald Eagle Creek.*

**When:** 8:45 AM-1:00 PM – Complementary lunch & refreshments served at 12:30.

**Stewardship Volunteer Positions Available:**

1. Join Clinton County CleanScapes (CCC) volunteers as they remove man-made & dumped woody debris from the PPL right-of-way from the Rt. 220 underpass to the historic Castanea Railroad train station. Volunteers will bag such items as plastic bottles & discarded household items, metal & tires. The right-of-way is flat and muddy; some side areas are heavily vegetated & steep. Woody debris can be sharp. Long pants, long sleeves, & closed toes shoes are mandatory (no bare feet, shorts or sandals). An extra jacket, shoes & socks are recommended. Waterproof boots are encouraged.

**Volunteer title: Beautification Crew.**

2. Amateur photographers are also encouraged to volunteer! If the volunteer does not own a camera, volunteers will be provided film, a disk or disposable camera. The cost of film developing will be paid through CCC with the understanding that one copy of the photographs will become the property of CCC & will be used for educational purposes.
