Dear Warden Rowley,

Congratulations on your passage of your 2016 Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) audit. As an auditor, I was impressed with the quick timeline in which you and your staff have come into compliance with the Department of Justice, Prison Rape Elimination Act Standards. Not only did you meet the requirements of thirty-eight of the standards you exceeded the requirements in two of the standards. Those two standards exceed the requirements due to your partnerships with both the Pennsylvania State Police in the investigation of incidents reportable under PREA and the Clinton County Women's Center for the advocacy and accompaniment to the forensic rape exams in addition to engaging the CCWC in the education programming of inmates on their rights under PREA.

Compliance with PREA standards is often challenging and a struggle for prisons. However, your staff was determined and committed to complete this task in a manner that was responsive to potential victims and created a fair and balanced process for investigation. I found your staff during formal interviews and in informal conversations during my time on-site were courtesy, professional, helpful and knowledgeable.
