What is Conservation Summer Day Camp?

A five day program with one overnight that gives students the opportunity to learn about their environment. The camp operates from 9 AM until 3:30 PM, Monday through Wednesday, and Thursday from 9 AM until Friday at noon. Thursday includes an off-site field trip and an overnight stay at the Sieg Conference Center near Lamar. Students will be picked up at Noon on Friday.

ELIGIBILITY:

Any Clinton County and/or Keystone Central School District student who has completed 4th, 5th, or 6th grade only is eligible to attend.

FEES:

The total cost per student will be \$85.

All information regarding the camp will be sent to registrants prior to the first day of camp. The camp is conducted by Camp Director Scott Koser and instructors and counselors from the Clinton County Conservation District and cooperating resource agencies.
