



Clinton County Natural Gas Task Force

Meeting Minutes

February 22, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Adam Coleman.

Mr. Kevin Fanning provided the report for the Public Safety Committee. He introduced Jim Watson who is the Director of the Clinton County GIS Department. Mr. Watson provided a report regarding his work to address well sites, specifically two wells off Pat's Ridge, Pads 285 G & F. This is a new road which needs a name suitable to DCNR.

Mr. Fanning reported that Exercise Design Group has partnered with Anadarko and O'Brien's Response Management to develop a table top exercise and a full scale exercise. Aero Terminal Services provided a presentation to the Public Safety Committee concerning the Hydrochloric Acid transfer station in Castanea Township. Mr. Fanning spent a significant amount of time discussing items specific to transportation such as the routing of traffic when Route 44 temporarily closed this summer and reporting and notification when an accident occurs. This would include water shed concerns. Anadarko is having a conference on March 1, 2011.

The next Public Safety Committee meeting is March 17, 2011.

Mr. Mike Flanagan provided a report for the Economic Development Committee. He reported that the gas industry is continuing to look at sites in Lamar and Renovo. Midstream Operations is opening an office in the outlet mall in McElhatten. There are twenty properties listed on the data base that are available for the gas industry. The committee will be meeting in March before the next Gas Task Force Meeting.

The Public Education Committee reported that the articles continue to be published in the Lock Haven Express. There will be a four part series on the Susquehanna River Basin. The Meet and Greet held 1/26/11 was a success. Over 250 people attended including 15-16 gas companies, and there were several sponsors. The Subcommittee has decided to plan another Meet and Greet which is scheduled for June.

Mr. Gerry Lacy provided a report for the Environmental Committee. He reported that they will be working with the Public Education Committee to provide information. They will be hosting a public forum to field questions and discuss water quality testing.

Mrs. Terry Acquino, Swissdale resident, attended the meeting and shared her concerns regarding the recent truck accident that dumped frac water onto a nearby property. She would like the process of testing private wells sped up. She shared her concerns with the

amount of truck traffic. The folks that live close to the accident cannot sleep due to the noise and now they are concerned about the water quality of their wells and their property value. Mr. John Wey stated that well owners should have their water tested annually no matter where they live to get a baseline.

Wes Carson provided a transportation update. He reported that Penn Dot is working with Anadarko and Range Resources on Route 664. Spring thaw is showing signs of deterioration. G. O. Hawbakers will be the contractor and work should be starting very soon. There was a discussion on bond permits

Joe Greco, Director of Exploration Services for Clean Harbors provided a presentation on their services. They provide energy and industrial, environment, and hazardous waste management services.

The next Task Force Meeting will be held on March 29, 2011 at 4:00 PM in the Commissioners' Meeting room.
