



Clinton County Natural Gas Task Force

Meeting Minutes

March 29, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Adam Coleman.

Mr. Kevin Fanning provided the report for the Public Safety Committee. He reported that currently there are thirty five production sites and nine support sites. The table top exercise and a full scale exercise with Anadarko will be the week of May 16. The next Public Safety Committee meeting will be in May.

Mr. Mike Flanagan provided a report for the Economic Development Committee. The Committee continues to update the data base of properties that are available for the gas industry. The Committee will continue to meet on an as needed basis.

The Public Education Committee reported that the next Meet and Greet is scheduled for June 15th at the Sons of Italy Campground at 5:00 PM. The Central Susquehanna Oil and Gas Expo is 5/7 from 10 AM – 3 PM at the Lycoming County Fairgrounds. The website for the Expo is www.centralsusquehannaoilandgasexpo.com. The Marcellus Shale Education Trailer will be at Central Mountain High School on 5/5, in Lycoming County on 5/6, and at the Expo on 5/7. The newspaper columns continue weekly.

Mr. Gerry Lacy provided a report for the Environmental Committee. He reported that they are setting up a forum regarding water supply testing for well owners who could be affected by the gas industry. The purpose of the forum is to publicize and recommend that well owners have their water tested and educate them on how to have it tested.

Mr. Scott Owens reported for the Education Committee. He reported that there will be a Career Fair at CMHS on 5/5. They are working with the Careerlink to have local industries including gas companies attend the career fair.

Mr. Coleman reported that Wes Carson is no longer working at PennDot therefore there will not be a transportation committee report. His replacement will be invited to join the Task Force.

Mr. Bruce Jones reported for the Workforce Development Committee. He reported that there were 15 gas related industry hires in January, 65 in February, and 40 to date in March. There is a career fair on 4/7 from 10 AM - 2 PM at Careerlink.

Mr. Brian Chilton from HB Rentals provided an overview of their services. They provide onsite accommodations at rigs to make the life of the gas industry workers more comfortable. They hope to employ up to sixty workers over the next couple of years.

Mr. Matt Carmichael from Anadarko provided an update on the accident on Route 664. He reported that all the dirt has been removed. Well water testing is continuing and there are no signs of contamination. The guardrail has been repaired. They will be meeting with KCSD regarding truck traffic soon.

Mr. Jamie Kelly thanked the Commissioners for their comments on the deer management problem.

The next Task Force Meeting will be held on April 26, 2011 at 4:00 PM in the Commissioners' Meeting room.
