



Clinton County Natural Gas Task Force

Meeting Minutes

April 26, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Adam Coleman.

Mr. Kevin Fanning provided the report for the Public Safety Committee. He reported that there are two additional addressed well pads sites with a total of 46 sites. The Anadarko situation manual should be done in early June.

Mr. Mike Flanagan provided a report for the Economic Development Committee. The Committee continues to update the data base of properties that are available for the gas industry. Some gas companies will be in attendance at the Clinton County Expo on May 11th.

The Public Education Committee reported that the next Meet and Greet is scheduled for June 15th at the Sons of Italy Campground from 5:00 PM to 7:30 PM. The Central Susquehanna Oil and Gas Expo is 5/7 from 10 AM – 3 PM at the Lycoming County Fairgrounds. The Marcellus Shale Education Trailer will be at Central Mountain High School on 5/5, in Lycoming County on 5/6, and at the Expo on 5/7. The newspaper columns continue weekly. The Environment and Education Committees are establishing a forum to test water supplies: 5/19/11 at Chapman Twp fire hall at 6 PM and 6/9/11 at the EMS building at 6 PM.

Mr. Gerry Lacy provided a report for the Environmental Committee. He reported that their efforts are focused on the upcoming forum. They reported a concern regarding a well pad in Sproul forest. Someone in attendance mentioned that trucks are not signed properly and some trucks are leaking on the roads. Mr. Fanning stated that there are standards set forth that if a truck is carrying certain fluids or quantities they require a placard. Frac water is not a hazardous substance.

Mr. Coleman reported that there is not a PennDot representative yet. He introduced Mary Wolfe from Anadarko. She reported on the roads that are being repaired by Anadarko.

Mr. Bruce Jones reported for the Workforce Development Committee. He reported that there were 104 hires in February and March. The March unemployment rates are as follows: County 7.4%; State 7.8%; US 8.8%. He mentioned a number of gas companies that are recruiting out of the CareerLink.

Additional concerns were discussed regarding truck traffic on roads.

Ms. Mitzi Gallagher encouraged everyone to attend Representative Hanna's Meet and Greet on May 5, 2011.

The next Task Force Meeting will be held on May 31, 2011 at 4:00 PM in the Commissioners' Meeting room.
