



Clinton County Natural Gas Task Force

Meeting Minutes

May 31, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Adam Coleman.

Mr. Kevin Fanning provided the report for the Public Safety Committee. He reported that there are three additional addressed well pads sites with a total of 49 sites. The table top exercise is scheduled for June 16th at 6:30 PM. It will be hosted by Croda at their facility. A meeting with Keystone Central School District was held last Tuesday regarding transportation safety. There was excellent dialogue and it was stressed that busing continues throughout the summer. The committee is lining up presenters to talk to the committee at their meetings about topics related to safety.

Mr. Mike Flanagan provided a report for the Economic Development Committee. The Committee continues to update the data base of properties that are available for the gas industry. They developed a handout with the names of the properties.

The Public Education Committee reported that the next private drinking water testing forum is June 9th from 6-7:30 PM at the EMS building in Lock Haven. The forum in Chapman Township was successful with approximately 30 people attending. The Meet and Greet is scheduled for June 15th at the Sons of Italy Campground from 5:00 PM to 7:30 PM. M & R Contracting and Harger Construction are the major sponsors. The newspaper columns continue weekly.

Mr. John Way provided a report for the Environmental Committee. He reported that they met with the Public Education Committee regarding the private drinking water testing forum. Ms. Mary Ann Bower reported that Headwaters received a grant for private well testing. More information regarding the grant will follow.

There was not an Education or Transportation Committee report.

Mr. Flanagan reported that there are approximately 330 gas related employees in Clinton County. The unemployment rate in March was 7.4% which is down two points from a year ago.

Ms. Mary Wolfe, Anadarko, provided an update on road work being completed by Anadarko. Anadarko is on the Planning Commission agenda in June for the water withdrawal site along the Renovo Road.

Mr. Jim Ladlee, Penn State Cooperative Extension, provided the recent Marcellus Education fact sheet.

The next Task Force Meeting will be held on June 28, 2011 at 4:00 PM in the Commissioners' Meeting room.
