



## Clinton County Natural Gas Task Force

### Meeting Minutes

October 25, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Adam Coleman.

There was no report from the Workforce Development Committee.

There was no report from the Public Safety Committee.

There was no report from the Economic Development Committee.

The Public Education Committee reported that they continue to publish weekly articles in the Express.

Mr. Dan Vilello, DEP, reported that DEP continues to educate municipalities on municipal road agreements and they are encouraging solicitors to do a better job with the agreements. Agreements usually favor gas companies; however, Centre County has a good agreement that he is sharing with the municipalities.

There was no report from the Education Committee.

The Transportation Committee reported that Route 4003 in North Bend is being posted 10 ton. PennDot is looking into posting Rt.664 from Jay St. to Mill Hill as well. Damon Wagner is the new Penn Dot Maintenance Manager. Mr. Wes Carson, Anadarko, added that the improvements to Rt.664 and Hyner mountain road are completed. The Route 44 project is moving along. The water withdrawal projects continue on Rt.664 and Rt.44. Hawbakkers are to improve the shoulders on Rt. 664.

Bobby Maguire requested support from the Task Force to widen Dry Run Road to make a 15 mile loop instead of trucks traveling from Renovo through Lock Haven to Route 664 which makes it a 140 mile trip. Mr. Doug D'Amore discussed why that is not a possibility. A discussion continued about the possibility of changing the Hyner Mountain Road to enable this.

Mr. D'Amore provided an update of gas company activity in the Sproul State Forest.

Mr. Coleman announced that the next Task Force meeting is scheduled for December 13th, 2011 at 4:00 PM in the Commissioners' Meeting room.
